The current Isle La Motte Fire Station was built in May 1968. They added on to it in 1973 and again in 2006. It was started in the Grange Hall that was given to them. The Fire Station is still there after 40 years.

The Fire Trucks have hoses to help to put the fires out and save people from the fire. They have Fire Engines and Pumper Trucks. The Pumper trucks are trucks that have water in them. They get the water from the lake. They save people in the water with their boats.

The Firemen have tons of work to do. They are volunteers that know how to fight the fires and help people. When there is an emergency they go to the Fire Station, put on their helmets and their suits, and when the job is done, they go back to the station.
