The Post Office was in the village of Isle La Motte at the old Carson Store. Now it is the Crème Store.

The Post Office is special because there is only one in town. You can get stamps at the Post Office in Isle La Motte. You can mail letters and packages there. And you can get packages and letters back! The trucks help deliver mail so you can get mail. We can visit Phyllis there a lot too. It is important to have a Post Office in town so you can get mail.
