Construction was started in 1881 and finished in 1882. The Isle La Motte Bridge replaced various ferry services to Alburgh. It is a public highway, and it is open all the time at no charge. Initially the bridge charged a toll to cross. The state of Vermont owns the bridge. The bridge connects Isle La Motte to the town of Alburgh. The bridge also is a great fishing spot.
